1. Team using two (2) singles rankings.
2. Team using one (1) singles ranking.
3. A team using a protected ranking is positioned below the other team.
4. If teams have the same composition, priority is given to the the team with the strongest individual singles ranking. For teams using 2 doubles rankings, the fewest number of tournaments played then team with highest number of points.
